2027 D-DAY MEMORIAL PARADE AND CEREMONY – SAMPLE TOUR SCHEDULE COMMEMORATING THE 85TH ANNIVERSARY OF WWII

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 2: DEPARTURE

- Depart on your overnight flight to France – Be sure to sleep on the plane!

THURSDAY, JUNE 3: ARRIVAL IN FRANCE

- Arrival in Paris, Charles De Gaulle Airport. Retrieve your luggage, clear customs. Meet your full-time tour manager outside of Customs
- Board your private motor coach. Lite refreshments provided. Depart for Normandy (approximately 3-hour drive). You will make a lunch stop en route. Lunch will be at your expense
- Afternoon to visit the overlook at **Arromanches**. It was on the beach of Arromanches that, during the Invasion of Normandy immediately after D-Day, the Allies established an artificial temporary harbor to allow the unloading of heavy equipment without waiting for the conquest of deep-water ports such as Le Havre or Cherbourg
- Depart for the hotel for check in and overnight – Dinner provided at your hotel



SATURDAY, JUNE 5: PARADE

- European style breakfast provided at the hotel
- Transfer to **Utah Beach** for the **D-Day Commemoration Ceremony**. The World War II Utah Beach American Memorial commemorates the achievements of U.S. VII Corps forces that landed and fought in the liberation of the Cotentin Peninsula from June 6, 1944 to July 1, 1944
- Transfer to **Sainte-Mère-Église**, the first town liberated by American paratroopers on D-Day, to tour the town and prepare for the D-Day Memorial Parade
- Lunch provided
- Performance in the town square as part of the **Musical Salute to Liberation**
- Participate in the **D-Day Memorial Parade** through the village of Sainte-Mère-Église
- Dinner on own
- Return to your hotel for overnight



FRIDAY, JUNE 4 – MONT SAINT MICHEL

- European style breakfast provided at the hotel
- Transfer to the **American Cemetery** at Omaha Beach. Tour the Cemetery and Visitors Center. The Normandy American Cemetery and Memorial in France is located on the site of the temporary American St. Laurent Cemetery, established by the U.S. First Army on June 8, 1944 and the first American cemetery on European soil in World War II. The cemetery site contains the graves of 9,387 of our military dead, most of whom lost their lives in the D-Day landings and ensuing operations.
- Visit Omaha Beach
- Transfer to **Mont St. Michel** for a tour of this one-of-a-kind medieval town and fortress abbey (Lunch on own at your leisure at Mont St. Michel)
- Depart for the hotel for overnight
- Group dinner provided at the hotel



SUNDAY, JUNE 6: UTAH BEACH CEREMONY

- European style breakfast provided at the hotel
- Transfer to the **Bayeux** for a morning to visit this historic and quaint French village
- Transfer to Paris
- Arrival into Paris – dinner and overnight at your Paris area hotel

MONDAY, JUNE 7: PARIS

- European style breakfast provided at the hotel
- Morning to enjoy a **Seine River** cruise with guided narration
- Lunch on own
- Afternoon of shopping and sightseeing in Paris
- Dinner provided
- Evening to enjoy Paris at your leisure
- Return to your hotel for overnight



TUESDAY, JUNE 8: PARIS

- European style breakfast provided at the hotel
- Morning to visit **Versailles**
- Lunch on own
- Optional afternoon performance in Paris at the beautiful **Jardin d'Acclimatation**
- Final evening and farewell dinner in Montmartre. Montmartre is primarily known for the white-domed Basilica of the Sacré Cœur on its summit. Many artists had studios or worked in or around Montmartre, including Salvador Dalí, Amedeo Modigliani, Claude Monet, Piet Mondrian, Pablo Picasso, Camille Pissarro and Vincent van Gogh.
- 9:00 Return to the hotel for overnight



WEDNESDAY, JUNE 9:

- European style breakfast provided at the hotel
- Departure for the airport, Charles de Gaulle
- Departure for the US on your scheduled airline
